

MARY MOPPINS "I CAN SEE CLEARLY NOW"

"I can see clearly now, the rain is gone, I can see all obstacles in my way. Gone are the dark clouds that had me blind. It's gonna be a bright, bright Sun-Shiny day." Sung by Johnny Nash, those bright sun-shiny days may be cloudy depending on the condition of a coach's windows and windshields. Water spots, streaks and bugs all hamper the view. Although singing a song helps lighten a cleaning chore, it does little against bug ridden, smear infested windows. Let's put a boot to these window issues.

Remember glass is porous. Bugs, water spots and other nuisances work into the pores and like a two year old tossing fits, they stubbornly refuse to budge.

Side windows are often covered with a dark sheet that provides a layer of privacy as well as helps reduce heat in the summer. Use caution when cleaning these windows. Do not rub near the edges as the sheet can pull loose then allows liquid to seep behind the sheet and loosen them. Use a soft baby diaper cloth to wipe around the edges. Avoid the use of microfiber as it will scratch the film.

Blotches: People often ask how to remove blotches, water droplets and fog on windows. These issues are caused by a leak in the seal around the window that allows the elements to gain access to the airspace between the panes of glass. Nothing will improve these issues. The glass must be replaced.

Water Spots: Run your thumbnail along a spot. Water spots are rough with a gritty feel. Work in the morning or early evening and out of the sun so the vinegar does not dry so quickly. Bring straight food grade distilled white vinegar to a boil. Thoroughly saturate the spots. Repeat every five minutes for at least 30 minutes to insure the spots stay damp. Vinegar is a mild acid and dissolves the alkali in the water so spots can be removed.

Caution: Keep a dry towel handy to wipe off any vinegar that might drip onto the paint.

Next grab a non-scratch white scrub pad found in the grocery store. Dampen it with the boiling vinegar and a bit of baking soda. Scrub heartily to remove the spots. Repeat if necessary. Remember glass is porous. Water spots etch into glass. The whitish look can be removed but the etching is permanent.

**Never use the scrub pad or baking soda on side windows with the film.*

Should the spots cover the entire windshield, work in sections otherwise the vinegar dries too rapidly and will not dissolve the spots.

Bugs: Ah, bugs - an easy issue to resolve. Microfiber pads come in two different styles. One is course and used for wet floor mopping. The other is soft for dusting floor. Dampen the course pad with water only and go over the windshield twice. Switch to the soft pad to dry. Glass is one of the few surfaces that tolerate the abrasive side of microfiber.

Smears: Avoid them by using a streak free window cleaner sans the ammonia. Proper laundering of towels also helps reduce the smudges. Use an organic detergent like Bio-Kleen found at health food stores. Add 1/3 cup distilled white vinegar in the rinse water of front loading machines or 1/2 cup for top loaders. Vinegar removes the soap residue, which often causes smears.

FYI: The folks who repair windshield chips advise against the use of RainEx on windshields. There is a chemical in it that prevents the glue used in chip repairs from adhering to the glass.

DEBORAH'S RV LIVABILITY Q&A COLUMN - Humidity

Where ever you travel in your RV you experience moisture from various climate conditions. Humid hot summers or snowy winters both produce moisture that can break down the bond in laminated materials, cause expansion in wood and moisture collection in fabric. For this reason you need to take precautions to protect the humidity of your coach.

During use this isn't as much a concern because you run your air conditioner and heater or have your windows or doors open that remove excess moisture from the air. Always run the ceiling fan and open the vent while showering and use your stove hood fan to eliminate moisture caused by cooking. During storage the moisture content in the air will be more severe depending on the climate and conditions you have to store your coach.

Optimal storage would be in a contained garage, especially one equipped with climate control! But the majority of us don't have that option available. So when storing your RV in open air, be sure the roof is leak free and/or you have a storage roof over the coach as in a coach port. It is not suggested to tarp over the coach because this actually causes a vapor barrier for moisture to grow.

The perfect interior humidity varies depending on the source but most agree it should measure between 40% to 50%.

The quickest way of measuring humidity is to use a hygrometer. The two below are both under \$25.00



Xikar Digital Hygrometer



GSI Handheld Hygrometer

Your best defense against humidity during storage is the use of a dehumidifier. Refrigerant Dehumidifiers need a main electricity supply or generator, like the **Soleus CFM25E** (below), a slimmer compact electric dehumidifier.



If you do not have the convenience of an electrical supply you may select one of the several wireless dehumidifiers, such as the **Eva-Dry 500 Mini-Dehumidifier** (below).



Finding the right dehumidifier for your RV is important for storage and year round comfort. I hope this information will help you in deciding what option is best for your needs.




