What Do You Do At a Motorhome Rally?

That was the question we heard over and over when we told our family and friends we were attending a rally. We didn't know what to answer at first because we had no experience with motorhome rallies and very little experience with motorhomes at all!



We discovered the answers pretty quickly. **The best part of a rally is the people.** You have an opportunity to meet quite a few like-minded people and perhaps kindle deep friendships with them. The attendees are from all walks of life and each and everyone has a story to share. During the free time and dinners, we have a chance to get to know each other. **We share information on our coaches** and look for answers to problems we are trying to solve. Usually the problems are on our coaches but we weren't surprised to have personal problems solved as well. **Each rally location has an infinite number of activities for the participants.** The schedule is limited and there are a handful of scheduled events for the group. But there is nothing to stop you from arriving early or staying late to take in more of the area. Aside from the very first rally we attended in New Orleans in 2004, **we have stayed in the area to sightsee and explore at almost every other location.**

Each rally host couple sets up the entertainment and menus. Some of the meals are catered and some are potluck. At

times you are on your own and that is the best time to share a meal with some friends. **We have watched countless entertainers** at the rallies - singers, dancers, hypnotists, ventriloquists, magicians, and more. We have taken rides on trains, riverboats, steamboats, and toured too many places to list.

In case the previous items weren't enough, there is another good part of attending a rally. **Service for your coach** is sometimes available so you can fix things while you are having a good time. Our group is supported by some very capable coach mechanics that can diagnose and fix the majority of the things that your coach needs. Even if there isn't a mechanic at the rally, the **other coach owners are an invaluable source of information.** It is unlikely that you will have a problem that someone else hasn't already tackled.

A rally is just a forum for good friends and good entertainment. That is the answer to the original question. **CCI is now working to form rally partnerships with area clubs.** We would like to work with your regional club and co-host a rally to make new friends and memories. 
California Here We Come!

RV SHIPMENTS CLIMB THROUGH FIRST HALF OF 2014

The RV market continued to strengthen in the first half of 2014 with total RV wholesale shipments reaching 192,065 units through June, an increase of 9.8% over the 174,918 units shipped during the same time frame in 2013 according to RVIA's June 2014 survey of manufacturers.

Towable RV shipments, representing 87.8% of all RVs manufactured, led the way in volume total with shipments reaching 168,737 units through June, an 8.6% gain over the 155,446 units shipped during the same six-month time frame in 2013. Conventional travel trailers remained the largest volume category reaching 119,861 units on 10.3% growth. Fifth wheels are up 8.4% to 41,245 units.

Meanwhile, motorhome shipments, accounting for 12.2% of the RV market, showed the largest percentage gain with the market segment up nearly 20% to 23,328 units compared to 19,472 units last year at the same point. Type A motorhome shipments have climbed 22.7% to 11,274 units; type B motorhomes are up 43.8% to 1,595 units; and type C motorhomes have reached 10,459 units on 14% growth.

On a seasonally adjusted basis, shipments through June were at an annualized rate of more than 350,000 units, which is slightly ahead of the 349,400 unit projection for 2014 shipments by Dr. Richard Curtin in the Summer 2014 issue of RV Roadsigns, RVIA's quarterly forecast of RV deliveries to RV retailers.
