

Checking Your Towed Vehicle Connections

Recent reports on some of the RV website forums of tow bar or hitch failures point out that some of us may not have our towed vehicle connections set up properly or that we need to visually inspect the towing hardware more often.

Many of the reports of tow failures also report that the towed vehicle struck the back of the coach while the driver was stopping the coach causing damage to both coach and towed vehicle. Some have reported multiple collisions between the coach and towed vehicle as they tried to stop. To eliminate this problem, the length of the break-away switch cable needs to be short enough to pull out of the switch before the safety cables reach their maximum length. It is easy enough to check your set up. Position the towed vehicle behind the motor home and connect the safety cables and break-away switch cable to the towed but do not connect the tow bar. If your safety cables are attached to or within the tow bar it may be necessary to support the tow bar to keep it at the height it would be if connected. Gently back the towed vehicle away from the coach until the safety cables are at their maximum length. If the break-away switch plug did not pull free then its cable needs to be shortened.

One other check for the break-away switch cable length is to find a parking lot and make the sharpest possible turn in each direction to make sure that the break-away switch cable is not so short that it pulls the plug free with these turns. This problem may be caused by the connections for the break-away switch cable being too far from the center of the two vehicles.

It is a good idea to pull your break-away switch cable plug out and see if the towed vehicle brake pedal is depressed. If you have a brake system operated by your coach's air brake system it will be necessary to make sure you have air in the towed brake system's emergency air supply. This check should be done frequently as the contacts in the switch can corrode and prevent the signal from getting to the braking system. And, always put a dummy plug in the switch when not towing to prevent insects from building nests in the switch and prevent water intrusion that can corrode the contacts.

The safety cables should be crossed under the connection at the coach. The passenger side coach safety cable needs to go to the driver's side connection on the towed vehicle.

Checking Your Towed Vehicle Connections

The driver side safety cable needs to go to the passenger's side connection on the towed vehicle. This cable configuration is done to prevent the tow bar near the coach from dropping to the ground should the hitch fail at that point and causing the towed vehicle to be pole vaulted into the air.

Often a drop hitch is required to make sure the coach receiver height is within specifications for the towed vehicle connection. Tow bar manufacturers recommend no more than +/-3 inches in height difference between the coach and the

towed connections. The drop hitch should be inspected periodically for cracks at the welds or to see if a part is bent. In addition to checking the drop hitch, look over all your tow equipment when you connect the towed vehicle to see if you notice a problem. Check welds on the equipment to see if there is a crack forming. Are the lynch pins inserted properly and with no apparent wear or distortion? If using padlocks instead of lynch pins, pull on the locks to make sure they are secure. We aren't experts in failure analysis but sometimes these things are obvious if we just look.

One last point. Please read the owner's manual for your tow bar and towed vehicle braking system. If you don't have the manuals, go online to the manufacturers' website and download the manuals.

HWH - Active Air Suspension - Part 2

We now have put over one thousand miles on the coach with the active air on our Affinity. You get spoiled quickly to the ease of driving and not having to manage the tilt and roll while driving. Changing lanes and getting on and off the freeways is easier due to the increased coach stability. The four to six seconds it takes to level when you park still surprises me. It moves quickly!

The overall system is quite impressive. One gripe is the location of the HWH panel down low in the middle of the dash. You have to reach down to it to raise the tag for turning. That is not really an issue for HWH, it is just where our control panel was located. I have tried to lift the tag with the old switch to the left of the driver's seat many times but it doesn't function any more.

You can view the line pressures of the air system and see that one side is boosted up in cross winds. There is more information that I personally need on the active air system but some people will appreciate it. I just want it to work and I am happy.

You will appreciate this system if you travel a lot in your coach. I feel like it is a good value and it makes driving so much easier. Feel free to call or message if you have any questions. Safe travels!





