

# How can I improve my Dry Camping?

## **Question:**

How can I improve my dry camping capability?

## **Answer:**

The simplest answer, and by far the most economical, is to reduce your use of the coach's electrical system. Here are some suggestions:

1. Turn off the inverter when AC power is not required. Although the inverter has an energy saving idle or 'search' mode, in practice it never activates due to parasitic loads such as the microwave clock and 'standby circuits' in TV's and VCR's, etc. Turning the inverter off when you are sleeping, for example, can gain you as much as three to four hours of dry camping time. When plugged in, the inverter can safely remain on.
2. Avoid or limit your use of AC heat producing appliances such as small heaters, the microwave, toasters, curling irons, and coffee makers, etc. If making coffee, just make enough for one cup each and then turn the coffee maker off to prevent the 'hot plate' from discharging your batteries further. A microwave, for example, can pull over 130 amps from the batteries in use.
3. Avoid using bay freezers when dry camping, but if necessary, these should be powered by 12V with the temperature setting adjusted to a minimum.
4. When using your propane or diesel heating system, reduce the temperature settings and use warmer clothing or bedding.

# How can I improve my Dry Camping?

5. Turn off any lights and fans, etc. that are not being used. If the icemaker in your refrigerator runs on inverter power, then this should also be turned off.

An important consideration when recharging your batteries is how long the generator will have to run to obtain a full charge. For heavily discharged batteries, this can vary from three hours for two 8D liquid cell batteries, to over ten hours for four AGM batteries. Owners of coaches with larger battery banks will unlikely run their generator long enough to fully charge their batteries and therefore usually experience reduced dry camping time after their initial arrival.

If your budget allows, installing solar panels will significantly increase dry camping time, and the energy they produce is free, silent, and environmentally friendly. Solar panels do have a limited output however, so maximum gains will be achieved when they are used in conjunction with the energy saving suggestions above.

# Thousand Trails

We went full-time RVing in August 2019. We took our inaugural trip with our eldest grandson Hunter, he was 18, for three months we visited North Dakota, Minnesota, Wisconsin, Ohio, New York, Massachusetts, Indiana and home. We used our Passport America for occasional deals, our Good Sam's membership for campground discounts an occasional Wal-Mart, a couple of Moose Lodge parking lots and finally six Harvest Host stops.

The overall cost wasn't bad, but it was a big difference from our pre-retirement practice of two to three weeks at a time and using Corps of Engineer parks frequently. We started doing some research. We kept hearing about Thousand Trails and how much you can save. The problem we saw was most of their campgrounds are along the coasts & none really in the heart of the country. It didn't seem to fit us.

Fast forward to our first winter. We chose Clerbrook Golf & RV Park in Clermont, Florida. It had a golf course & was centrally located in the state. We paid a \$650 monthly fee plus utilities. We really enjoyed the winter, but we needed to figure out a way to save some dinero!

We did more research and discovered you could purchase a used nationwide Thousand Trails membership for a pretty steep discount. This would include 81 campgrounds that are divided among five camping zones: Northwest (18), Southwest (18), Midwest (8), Northeast (14) and Southeast (23). The downside is Thousand Trails doesn't cover much in the heart of America, its more "coastal."



# Thousand Trails

Brand-new nationwide memberships were going for \$10,000 to &12,000. Wowza! Luckily for us there is a business that sells used memberships in Minneola, FL about five miles from our campground in Clermont.

So, we made a trip to Campground Membership Outlet ([www.campgroundmembershipoutlet.com](http://www.campgroundmembershipoutlet.com)) and a meeting with manager Kimberly Hoel. Kim was AWESOME. She explained the entire process, membership levels and costs. It turns out that there is a pretty big array of previously owned memberships for sale. From Zone memberships, which are multi-state options, think Southeast or Midwest. Plus, the big national plans. Then there are upgrades to the packages that lengthen the number of days you can stay plus how far out in advance you can reserve a campsite.

Once we decided to make a purchase Kim started sending us email listings of all the different levels of memberships that were available. We knew we wanted an "Elite" membership, nationwide with at least 120 day advance reservations. We found one that we could book a reservation 180 days in advance instead of the usual 120 days out.

So, what did we get? We bought a Nationwide Elite membership for \$4200 (a one-time expense) from an individual that had listed it through Campground Membership Outlet. We had to pay Thousand Trails a \$750 transfer fee (also a one-time expense) and \$549 annual dues. Once we did that we could immediately start booking resorts, though we had to do it through phone support until the transfer was completed & the online booking program was available.

We booked a three week stay in Columbus, TX at Cottonwood RV. That's when COVID-19 hit. Thousand Trails allowed us to extend our stay to six weeks and we paid nothing (\$0), it was all included in the membership.

Once we got home in May we decided to join an affiliated campground club called Resort Parks International (RPI) (annual dues \$165). This allowed us to increase our number of options for campgrounds and significantly increased the options for camping in all 50 states. Thousand Trails campgrounds are free and the RPI are drastically reduced, generally costing around \$10 to \$20 a night.

We then upgrade our Thousand Trails Elite to include the optional Trails Collection (annual dues \$315) which now includes all Encore Parks (these are free too). That added over 100 more campgrounds!

How does this work? We camp at Thousand Trails & Encore parks for free. These are nice RV parks with all the amenities you would expect while camping. We didn't have any issues getting sites. If we stay in just Thousand Trail parks, we can stay for up to 21 days. We then have to leave the park, but we can go straight to another Thousand Trails park, still free. If we stay at an Encore park, we can stay for 14 days. After that we have to leave for at least seven days before we can go into another Encore park, but we can go into a Thousand Trails.

So, Winter 2021 we are part of the Thousand Trails "shuffle"! During prime snowbird season in Florida all Thousand Trails & Encore parks are limited to a 14 day stay. We stayed at the Clerbrook Golf & RV park for two weeks with our friends, leave for seven days, either a rally or go to Thousand Trails Orlando (15 mile drive) then back to Clerbrook Golf & RV. We don't pay a cent to camp and don't have to pay for electric. Fortunately, with a motorcoach its super easy to pack up and switch parks.

So, what are the true numbers like?

1000 Trails Membership	\$4200	One Time Fee
1000 Trails Trail transfer	\$750	One Time Fee
1000 Trails Annual Dues	\$549	Yearly Fee
1000 Trails Collection upgrade	\$315	Yearly Fee
Resort Parks International Dues	\$165	Yearly Fee
Total	\$5979	

# Thousand Trails

How much did we use it in the first year? In the 1000 Trails system, between March 2020 & October 2020 we camped 85 nights and saved \$4,458. Between November 2020 & March 2021 (Snowbirding) we camped 118 nights in the system and saved \$6,702.

That doesn't include the saving in the Resort Parks International system. There we camped 12 nights and saved \$479.50

So, the initial expense was \$5,979 and we saved \$11,639.50 on camping through the 1000 Trails system. We are up \$5660.50 in the first year and anticipate comparable camping nights over the next 12 months but will not have to pay the one-time fees of \$4,950. Significantly increasing our savings!!!

We also camped free in our daughters drive way (20 nights), Harvest Hosts (12 nights), Moose Lodges (8 nights), and Walmart's (8 nights).

So, all things being the same, we expect to pay \$1,029 for our fees and save \$16,589.00 in 2021 now that we have the hang of it, we will probably save even more.

# Position Drivers Seat for 2

Compiled from the Country Coach Tech Topics site by Mike Cebula

Question:

My Magna has a system that remembers how my co-pilot and I like to position the driver's seat and controls. How does that work? Is it tied into the memory system for the interior lighting?

Answer:

You've asked a great question. In answer, allow me to share some detailed information about that Driver's Area Memory System. At the touch of a switch this system automatically adjusts the cab-mirror heads, steering column, adjustable pedals, and the driver's seat to user programmable positions.

Operation 86

This standalone system operates primarily on a data bus network (Figure 2), allowing the Intellitec PMC Column/Pedal Control Module as well as control modules in the cab mirrors and driver's seat to communicate over a single pair of wires. The discrete 12VDC position commands sent over dedicated wires from the Intellitec PMC control module directly to the steering wheel and pedal positioning mechanisms are the only non-networked signals in this system.

<i>Component</i>	<i>Positioning Comands</i>
Driver's seat	Forwardbackward, recline, etc.
Exterior cab mirrors	Mirror pane right/left, up down
Steering wheel	Tilt and telescope
Pedals	In closer/out farther

Individual positioning commands for every component are stored together in a group. This group of positioning commands is called a positioning configuration. There are two of these groups; recall the desired configuration by pressing either the "1" or "2" switch on the Memory Switch Panel.
