

# Our First Motorhome Trip

In 2010 we bought our first motor coach, a 2002 40-foot Magna. It belonged to some good friends of ours who felt they were too “senior” to handle such a big coach. My wife told me “sure you can buy it if you intend to use it”. I promised that we’d actually take off for a couple of months that winter (early 2010).

The day we left, December 30th, 2009 it was cold, foggy and a 35 mile an hour quartering wind. So, as we went down the 4-lane, not only was it very difficult to drive, our window awning kept pulling out and flapping and banging against the side of the coach. The spring in the awning wasn’t adjusted properly. Some duct tape temporarily fixed that problem. A few miles further, there was water running across the kitchen floor. We also had wipers that were near worthless wiping the windshield. On top of that, the defrosters were almost non-existent in effectiveness.

I figured out myself that the vent louvers in the dash were installed BACKWARDS! The previous owner had apparently never needed to use the defrosters. This was an easy fix, I just reversed them. We made it to a dealer in Omaha who replaced the wiper blades and determined that the bypass on the water heater connections were loose, hence the water running across the floor. When I had tightened them up, it was so cold that I hadn’t got them to seal. The dealer applied air pressure to the water system and quickly determined that, and tightened up the fittings. No more leak! We left the duct tape on the awning and ordered a new spring to be shipped to an address that we hoped to end up in California.

We woke up the next morning to find that the power step was stuck in the in position which was a problem for my 5 ft. 4-inch wife. I was also having problems with the diesel furnace and generator stopping for no apparent reason! We went on towards central Colorado.

As we traveled, we were getting phone calls from my sister in Colorado warning us of a winter storm in NE Colorado. We diverted down to I-70 to avoid it. However, as we approached Limon Colorado, at the top of a hill I noticed just a little snow skimming across the road in the wind. It was just getting dark. By the time we reached top of the next hill it was a white out. I drove about 30 miles in a blizzard, with a car loaded on a trailer behind me to Limon and we pulled into a truck stop. By then, my furnace and generator wouldn’t run more than about 15 or 20 minutes without shutting down. I was exhausted and had to get some sleep. Since it was 10 below zero outside and the wind was blowing 35 miles an hour plus snowing very hard, I decided to leave the engine running (I was unable to use the

block heater since the generator wouldn't run and I was sure the coach wouldn't start in the morning as cold as it was) so we could keep warm.

Of course, the coach water system froze since the diesel furnace couldn't supply heat to the plumbing bay. However, after it thawed, there was no leakage!

After five hours of sleep, we pulled out. By then it had quit snowing but was still very cold and windy. We got to Colorado Springs hoping to find a dealer that could look at the generator and diesel furnace. It was Saturday, and being winter, nobody was open. So, we left Colorado Springs. I-25 south was like a war zone. There were stalled, and wrecked vehicles on their tops and sides everywhere. Many places there was one lane winding through all the vehicles. On our way to Pueblo we went from ice, to cobblestone like ice, to slush and finally wet roads. We had to go 100 miles west of Pueblo to my sister's house in Salida.

She had made friends with the local Ford dealer (just that day) and got him to allow us to park our coach inside his shop to thaw it out over the weekend. She had never met the man, but bless his heart he allowed us to park in his shop. He even allowed me to plug in, but with my inexperience, I didn't realize that using a 15-amp circuit popped his breaker and we ended up throwing away all the food in our fridge and freezer.

On Monday morning, the plumbing was thawed, the step worked, and we were able to go on our way. By the time we got done with our trip to Vegas, San Diego, Tucson, San Antonio, and Brownsville Texas we determined that awning spring wasn't broken, just not adjusted properly, the power cord reel motor started shorting out, (we had that fixed in California) and the problem with the diesel furnace and the generator was minute cracks in the fuel lines where they came out of the top of the fuel tank allowing the intake of air. This little problem took over \$3,000 to fix once we returned to Iowa. Those of you that are familiar know that the furnace fuel line runs the length of the coach through a sealed tube and every few feet is sealed in place with silicone.

But here's the unbelievable part.... we loved our trip and loved our coach. We did trade up to a 2006 Magna 45 foot in 2013, and have had our share of issues with it as well, (such as being broke down on Christmas Day trying to leave Iowa in order to make a 50th anniversary party in Dallas) I kind of thought that might be the good Lords way of punishing me for leaving on Christmas, but we still love coaching! Crazy, right?

Since then we've travelled to Alaska, western national parks, and all the way down the West coast with Fantasy caravans, as well as our winter trips to Dallas, San Diego, and ending up in Tucson for three months each winter.

1 ready-to-use graham cracker crumb crust  
(6 oz.)

1 cup thawed COOL WHIP Whipped Topping

1) Mix condensed milk, cinnamon, ginger and nutmeg with whisk until well blended.

2) Sprinkle gelatine over water in medium saucepan; let stand 1 minute. Cook on low heat 2 minutes or until gelatine is completely dissolved, stirring constantly. Add milk mixture, stir until blended. Continue cooking for 5 minutes or until slightly thickened. Remove from heat, stir in pumpkin. Spoon into crust

3) Refrigerate for 4 hours or until firm. Top each serving with a dollop of whipped topping
